




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What Parents & Carers Need to Know about

TixTok is a video-sharing social media app which lets people creats, view and download looping 15-second olips. Typically, these are videos of users lip-synaing and dancing to popular songs or soundbites (often for comic purposes), enhanced with filters, effects and text. Designed with young people in mind, TixTok skyroaketed in popularity in 2016 and has featured near the top of download charts ever since. It now has around a billion users worldwide.

AGE-INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT

Most videae appearing on a child's lead are light-hearised and amusing. Heariver, some clips have lead repaired for featuring drug and alcohol abuse, themse of suicide and setting in a security suggestive way. The sheer volume of upleads is impossible to moderate entirely – and since Tikflet Jump's introduction in mid-2021, users can view third-party content outside the app.

EXPLICIT SONGS

TikTok primerily revolves cround videos of users ilp-syncing and dencing to music. Insvitably, some featured surge will contain explicit or suggestine lyrics. Given the app's young users base, there is a risk that children may view older users where and then be inclined to imitate any explicit language or suggestive actions.

TIKTOK FAME

HAZARDOUS VISIBILITY

Connecting with others is simple on TikTol including commenting on and reacting to users' videos, following their profile and deamlocating their content. The majority of these interactions are harmless, but — isocruse of its abundance of been users—TikTok has experienced profilems with president contacting young people.

ADDICTIVE NATURE

Like all sectal media. TikTok is designed to be addictive. It can be hugely entertaining but that also makes it hard to put slown. A sell as the punchy nature of the short vide fermat, the appre ability to keep users intrigued about what's coming next mean it's easy for a 5-minute visit to turn into a 45-minute stay.

IN-APP SPENDING

There's an in-app option to purchase "Tikrek coins", which are then converted into digital research for conding to content orealers that a user likes Prices range fro tip to an eye-watering £86 journile. Tikre is also connected with Ehepity, which allows to key products through the app.



Advice for Parents & Carers

TALK ABOUT ONLINE CONTENT

Assuming your child is above TikTok's age limit, talk to them about what they've viewed on the app. Ask their opinion on what's appearance and what lan't. Explain why they shouldn't give out personal details or upleed visions which reveal information like their achies or home address. In the long run, teaching them to think critically about what they see on TikTok could help them to become social-media savey.

MAINTAIN PRIVACY SETTINGS

The default setting for all under 18s' accounts to 'private'. Keeping it that way is the arrest solution: it means early users whe your child approves can watch their videos. With the correct privacy settings applied, TikTok is a relatively sale spece. TikTok allows upen to report envore breaching its guidelines, while you can also block individual upers through their prefile.

ENABLE FAMILY PAIRING

'Parnity Pairing' lets perents and earers link their even Tikrek ascount to their child's. Through your mobile, you can centrel your child's safety settings remetely - including limiting screen time, managing their ability to exchange messages (and with whem) and blocking a let of age-inappropriate centent. Tikrek's Sefety Centre clase provides resources for perents and cerers to support online safety among families. These resources can be found on their website.

USE RESTRICTED MODE

in the app's 'Digital Wellbeing' section, you can lilter out inapprepriete sentent (specific content of the property of the instance) using 'Restricted Mode'. This can then be lected with a PR.
